Curriculum Years 7 – 9

The Key Stage 3 curriculum is designed to build on the learning experiences that children had in their primary schools. Students are taught in ability groupings from the start of Year 7 to allow appropriate and targeted challenge for all. We ensure our Key Stage 3 curriculum allows time for creativity in all aspects of the curriculum while providing a broad and balanced education.

Learning in Year 7 is organised into 5 bands (R,S,T,U,V)

Students are taught in ability groupings from the start of Year 7 to allow students to be challenged and progress at a rate appropriate for them. The school uses literacy catch up/ Pupil Premium funding to build in extra time for English lessons. Students in the V band have 7 periods of Literacy/English a week to ensure they make better than expected progress in literacy and allows them to cope with the increased rigor of the curriculum in subsequent years.
