Dear Parent and Guardian,

The National Citizen Service is working in partnership with your child's school to offer an exciting opportunity to all Year 11 students. NCS has been into the school and delivered a presentation in relation to what the programme has to offer the students. This opportunity takes place in the Summer break, once students have finished their GCSE's.

The NCS programme is a 4 week experience which is funded by the Government. The experience allows students to embark on exhilarating challenges, whilst also making their mark and building skills for work and life. The cost for one place on NCS is £1500, however as mentioned previously the experience is funded by the government, therefore the most any student will ever pay is a £50.00 admin fee for the whole programme.

****HOWEVER**, we currently have a special offer on for East Riding students where the programme is **only £35.00** – this includes all food, accommodation, qualifications and specialised equipment.

Below shows the breakdown of the programme:

Phase One (Adventure phase):

Phase one consists of a 4 night, 5 day residential (Mon-Fri) to one of our top Outdoor Activity Centres (more info can be found on www.flyingfutures.org) Here students will take part in lots of adrenaline fuelled activities to challenge themselves and their teammates!

Phase Two (Sharpen their skills):

Straight after Phase one students will come home for the weekend, before another 4 night, 5 day residential (Mon-Fri). Based at a University style setting, living like students, they take part in interactive workshops which will build their CV and boost their personal statements.



Phase Three (Social action):

The following 2 weeks are non-residential. During these 2 weeks students will meet within their teams in their local area to design and deliver a project that makes a difference.

We finish the NCS programme with a graduation celebration event in which students will receive all their certificates from phase two, but most importantly their NCS graduation pack. Within this graduation pack is a signed certificate from the Prime Minister which students can add to their CV's and Personal Statements for those next steps after completing their GCSE's.
